We accept art in all media. Each artist may submit up to four original works. Art previously submitted will not be considered. Work should be complete, dry and ready for display or hanging. Two dimensional works should have appropriate frames and hanging wires. Works should not exceed thirty square feet. Three dimensional works should be submitted with a base or display case if possible.

Applications: The deadline for submitting applications is **7pm, April 11, 2012**. Submit artwork and applications to St. Joseph Parish Office, 721 Chemeketa Street, Salem, OR 97301, or via email with photo to Marylen Amsberry, amsfive@wvi.com This is a juried show. Artists will be notified of acceptance by April 13, 2012. Artwork will not be for sale, but artists’ information will be available.

Delivering Accepted Artwork: Deliver artwork to St. Joseph’s Parish Office, 721 Chemeketa Street, Salem, OR 97301, between **April 14 and 18**, weekdays from 9am to 7pm and Saturday from 9am to 4pm.

Pick up Artwork: Artwork should be picked up immediately after the show on Saturday, April 21 at 3pm. They will be moved to the Parish Office after that for pickup. If someone else is picking up your work, they need to have written and signed permission from you.
